
First Presbyterian Choir Interns

Choir Interns will begin their fall semester on Wednesday, September 4, at 4:30-5:15 pm. Children in Grades 1-6 are welcome to attend. Our mission is to develop musical skills to use in our worship service. We learn that worship is for God, and our sessions focus on worship music in many different styles with activities that build skills in diction, singing, rhythm instruments, bells, basic music reading, and working as a group. We open each session with a devotion.

This fall we will be using the **Growing in Grace** music curriculum with the theme of "**We Are God's Masterpiece**" based on Ephesians 2:10. A few anthem titles are *God's Masterpiece*; I am Wonderfully Made; Praise the Lord Body, Mind, and Soul; You Know I Wanna Be; and Patapan. Hymns include Come, Christians Join and Sing; Take My Life and Let It Be; and O Come, O Come, Emmanuel.

We encourage regular weekly attendance since we will be presenting several anthems during fall worship services.
